

## Joomla-Template: reBase

The Joomla!-Template "reBase" by reDim is a modern template, which combines the newest standards of design, technology and aesthetics. It's compatible with Joomla! 3.x and every version thereafter. The template offers a lot of customization (for example: like background color, link color, page width and so on). Additionally it's W3C compliant, fully responsive and scripted with HTML5 and CSS3.

It avoids third-party scripts and uses as many Joomla! functions as possible.

# Template settings

## *Advanced*

- **Embedding own logo**

First upload your logo in the media area of Joomla!. Make sure you upload logos as png files with transparent background only. After that, you can choose your uploaded logo at the "logo"-parameter.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "advanced" -> logo

- **Configure page width**

You can change the value of the page width via the "page width" parameter in the template options. It's important to write "px" as the unit for the number. For example: if you want a width of 1200 pixels, then write "1200px" and nothing else.

- **Changing the google font**

Normally reBase uses the "Raleway" Google Font. If you want another one, you can change it in the template options.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "advanced"

- **Google Font**

First, insert the "family" parameter of the Google Font link in this textfield. With this, the template knows which Google Font it has to embed.

Example:

link: <https://fonts.googleapis.com/CSS?family=Raleway:400,700>. Type "Raleway:400,700" in the textfield "Google Font".

The only thing left to do is to set the font in CSS. Input the font-family value in the "CSS font-family" textfield. For example the CSS parameter „font-family: 'Raleway', sans-serif;“. You only need to insert the "'Raleway', sans-serif" part into the textfield.

- **Font size and line height**

Here you can change the font size of continuous text and its line height. Same with the page width, you need a unit. Use "px" for the font size and either "em" or "px" for the line height.

- **Sticky menu**

A sticky menu is a feature that sticks the menu at the top side of the browser, when that menu would disappear through scrolling down. You have the option to turn this function on or off. Just change the parameter at "sticky menu" in the template settings to either "yes" or "no" to enable or disable a sticky menu.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "advanced"

- **Addthis smartlayers**

At the left browser side appear social share buttons. These too, can be turned on or off. In the template settings at "addthis smartlayers" select either "yes" or "no" enable or disable them.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "advanced"

- **Menu logo**

A smaller version of the logo will appear, when you scroll down the page. You can turn this either on or off in the template settings at "menu logo".

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "advanced"

- **Social media icons footer**

If you provide a link to your own profile pages in the social networks Facebook, Twitter or Google+, a respective icon will appear in the footer area.

- **Copyright line**

If you want to disable the backlink in the standard copyright line, then select in the template settings at "copyright line" the parameter "no". Now you can use your own "copyright" at the respective module position. Neither breaks or paragraphs will be considered.

## Slideshow settings

- **Change slide-effect and speed**

You can change the slideshow options freely under the slideshow tab at the template settings.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "slideshow"

## Color settings

- **Change template colors**

The standard color of reBase is blue, but you can change the color to anything you want. In the template options, you can set the colors specifically for areas, passages and objects.

## Expert options

- **Pop-up session**

Look up „pop-up module" at the template functions.

- **Systemmessage as pop-up**

This option lets system messages display as pop-ups. Standardly system messages appear at the top of the screen.

- **Expert options – template layout (spans)**

The template uses Bootstrap as a core framework and always assumes an arrangement of twelve parts (spans). Because Bootstrap normally can't make 5, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 spans with the same width, special exceptions had to be set. Only for experts!

# Additional functions, classes and objects

- **Buttons**

To display links in form of a button, insert in your text or module a link and give it the "button" class:

```
<a href="/testsite/" class="button">button</a>
```

- **Pop-up module**

The pop-up module gives you the option to display a module as a pop-up. Set a module at the position "popup". The module will be appear at your next page visit as a pop-up. If more than one pop-up module on one page, the pop-ups will be displayed one after another. Should there be only one pop-up at the first page visit then select „yes" at "pop-up session" in the template options. With this option the user won't get spammed by pop-ups.

Extensions / template manager / reBase / tab: "expert options"

- **Dynamic slideshow**

To display your own pictures in the slideshow, use the "single article" module of Joomla!. Make a new module with the "single article" type, then insert an image via the "image" button below the editor. This image will be one of the slideshow images. Its module title will be the image title. Any text in that module will be displayed as the slider text below its title.

Now set that module at the "slideshow" position at any pages you want. Do these steps with additional modules. If more than one slider-module are set at one page, every set slider will be combined there to one. If there is only one slider, then there won't be a slideshow.

If you don't want an image title, just disable the module title in the module options.  
If you don't want a additional text below the image, let the content area empty.

Tipp: only use images with the same height. The slideshow height is based on the image heights.

## • Module positions

The template has its own module positions for many different layouts. You can find every single position in the graphic below.



- **Bootstrap functions**

Every function or class of Bootstrap can be used, as long as they don't interfere with the template layout. Special objects got overwritten by the template and won't be affected by the normal Bootstrap format.

- **Own stylesheet file**

If important adjustments have to be made, use the "template-overwrite.css" in the template folder. Make CSS adjustments only, when you know how HTML and CSS works.

- **Module types (box, bar, default)**

Rebase offers 3 different module types.

<i>Default:</i>	<i>standard module without stlyes.</i>
<i>Box:</i>	<i>fully bordered in a single box (sub color)</i>
<i>Bar:</i>	<i>module title in a bar (in font color)</i>

Usage: open your module, which should get one of the style mentioned. Click on the "advanced" tab. Type in the "module class suffix" text area either "box" or "bar" then save.
